- One entry per house. Entrants must live in the Great Chart with Singleton Parish area
- Registration will be open 01/10/2021 to 18/10/2021
- Entry forms will be under Events at <u>www.greatchartsingleton-pc.gov.uk</u>
- THE OVERALL THEME WILL BE NURSERY RHYMES
- Scarecrows must be at least 1.5m tall
- Scarecrows must be displayed on private property but should be easy to view from the edge of the property
- Visitors should not access the private property of those taking part
- Scarecrows must be weatherproof for the 3 days of voting, and suitably secured to avoid them becoming a danger to others
- If you do not have anywhere suitable to display a scarecrow, please contact the Parish Council
- Scarecrows must be displayed from 9am 29/10/21 to the end of 31/10/21. A check will be made soon after 9am on the 29th to ensure maps are correct.
- All registered scarecrows will need to clearly display the ID number which will be emailed after registration
- Only registered scarecrows displaying ID numbers will be voted on
- Voting starts at 9am 29/10/21 and ends at 12pm 01/11/21. Winners will be announced w/c 08/11/21
- The scarecrow that receives the most votes will be the overall winner.
- There will be 3 categories which will also have a winner. These are: #Reduce#Reuse#Recycle, Most Creative/Unusual and Under 12's
- Scarecrows must be suitable for family viewing, offensive scarecrows will be disqualified
- By taking part you agree to photos being taken of your scarecrows which may be used on social media
