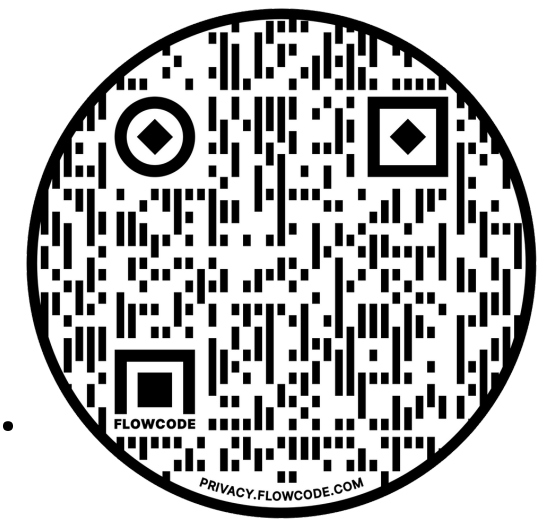


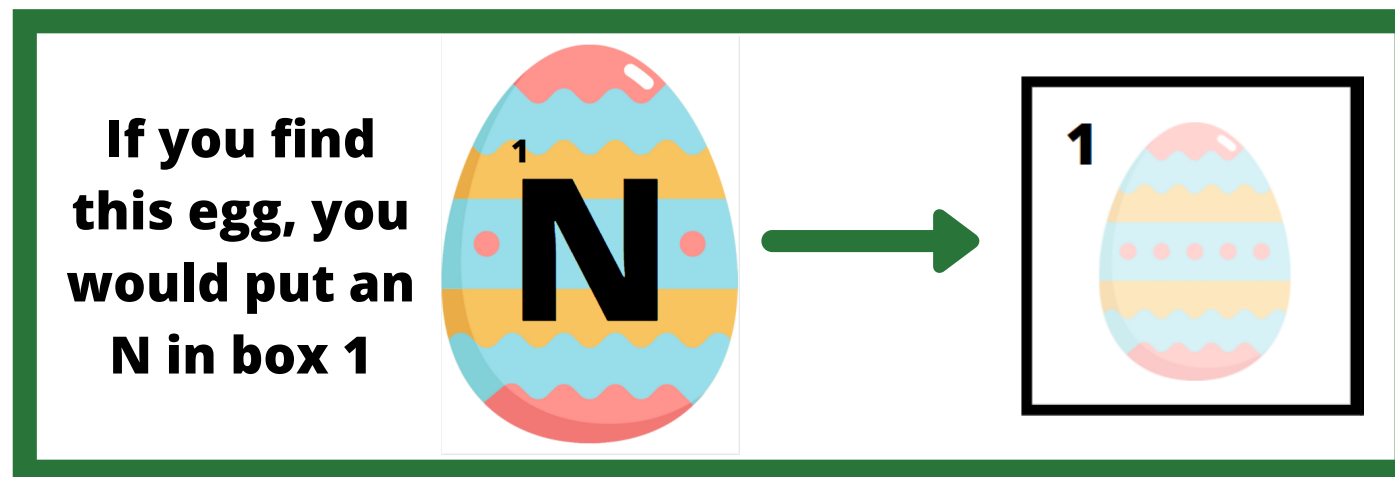
EASTER TRAIL ANSWER SHEET

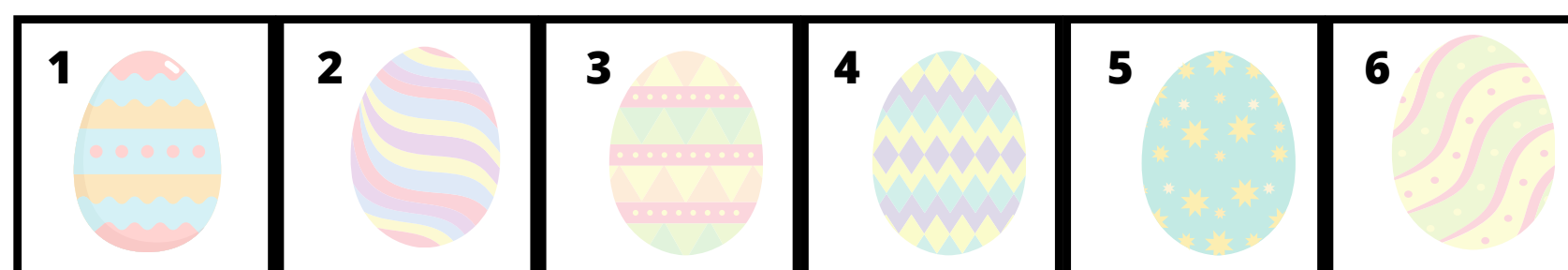
When you find an egg, write the letter into the correct number box and see if you can complete the word for each area, and all three areas if your legs have enough energy in them.



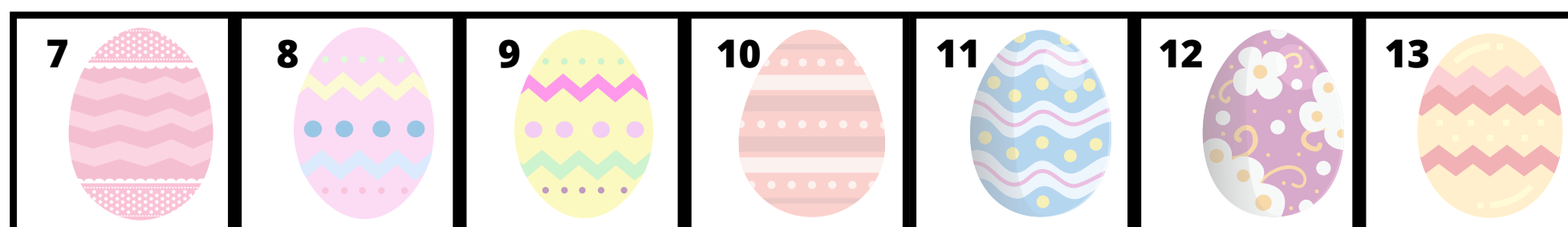
