THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ASHFORD) (SPEED LIMITS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER2020 (AMENDMENT NO.4) ORDER 2021

NOTICE is given that the Kent County Council hereby make an Order under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to reduce the 30MPH speed limit to a 20MPH speed limit in Singleton, Ashford on the following length of roads:-

ASKES COURT, BADGERS DEN, GREEN FIELDS LANE, GREYHOUND CHASE, HOXTON CLOSE, LODGE CLOSE, NORMANDY WAY, PERCH CLOSE, RUNNING FOXES LANE, SABRE CRESCENT and WESLEY SCHOOL ROAD, SINGLETON, ASHFORD – For their entire length.

The Order was made on 26 August 2021 and its provisions will come into effect on 1 September 2021.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 1st September 2021 and may be cited as 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ashford) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2020 (Amendment No.4) Order 2021' ('this Order').
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ashford) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2020' ('the Order of 2020') shall have effect as though:
