Urban South Ward News Update from your local beat officer - PC 13811 Adele Tyrer

Hello all,

Hope you are all well. This month has been a busy month and I have lots of results to share with you. In my last newsletter, I explained that I was focussing on the nuisance motorbikes in the Stanhope area. I am pleased to say that I have made an arrest and secured 4 charges against a suspect involved in the nuisance motorbikes in this area. He has since been dealt with at court and received a large fine and points on his driving license. If you have any information about any nuisance bikes or witness any inappropriate behaviour then please call police. It is imperative that all incidents are reported so that we can act on it and be robust in our approach.

I also received a number of reports regarding drug usage and antisocial behaviour in the area of THE LIMES, ASHFORD. I have been patrolling this area regularly and detained 5 people for a search. I recovered a quantity of drugs and the suspects have been dealt with. This result was made possible by regular reporting from a local resident which I have acted upon. I will continue to patrol this area in an effort to reduce any further drug usage and anti-social behaviour.

Lastly, I held an engagement on Friday 1st March 2024 at The Singleton Environment Centre. Thankyou all who attended, it was great to see you there and discuss issues in the local community. I will be holding additional events over the course of this year which will be advertised on My Community Voice.
