4.2. Application Number 20/01806/AS

Land north Stubbs Cross, Magpie Hall Road, Kingsnorth, Kent. Construction of a Wastewater Pumping Station associated with vehicular access and landscaping bund.

The group resolved to object due to the following reasons:

- Concern about the location of the entrance being too close to the junction of Long Length. The proximity can potentially make the exit/entrance dangerous.
- Concern regarding wheel washing during construction and mud on road as the area tends to get very icy during winter months.
- The vehicle tracking information shows that lorries will have to potentially drive on the

other side of the road to gain access and also when leaving the site. This can potentially cause a risk.

- Due to the road width of Chilmington Green Road there is concern that two lorries will not be able to pass each other.
- Speed limit the proposed 40-60 mph speed limit just before the entrance and junction is a huge concern as it can be dangerous. The parish council would like to see the speed limit set at 40 mph along the whole of Chilmington Green Road
