5. Tree Management

Ashford Borough Council is currently in the process of inviting residents of the borough to be Tree Champions. The scheme objective is to build a network of people who would help champion trees, within their volunteer role of Tree Wardens, they would also be able to organize events to promote trees, set up tree nurseries and talk to young people about the value of trees.

6. Pesticide Free Zones

No update. The Clerk informed members that the council is now using white vinegar to spray weed in parish owned amenities.

7. Allotments

The allotment still has a long waiting list, the committee discussed the possibility of extending the existing site to the site's boundary. The Clerk to check if the footpath that runs along the fence is part of the Public Right of Way. If it is the path might have to be relocated.

A Summer plot inspection will be arranged for the end of July 2021.

The committee briefly discussed the parking issues and agreed that plot holders should park in the village hall car park as per their agreement and only use the car park near the allotment as a drop off point.

The security of the site will need to be reviewed and plans to improve it agreed with the Barrow and Spade Brigade. Also, potential funding needs to be identified to complete any proposed work.
