



SCARECROW TRAIL RULES

- One entry per household. Entrants must live in the Great Chart with Singleton Parish, this includes Chilmington.
 - Registration will open on Saturday 01/10/2022
 - Entry forms can be found under Events at www.greatchartsingleton-pc.gov.uk
 - **THIS YEARS THEME WILL BE BOOK CHARACTERS**
 - Scarecrows must be at least 1 metre tall.
 - Scarecrows must be displayed on private property but should be easy to view from the edge of the property.
 - Visitors should not access the private property of those taking part
 - Scarecrows must be weatherproof for the 3 days of voting, and suitably secured to avoid them becoming a danger to others.
 - If you do not have anywhere suitable to display a scarecrow, please contact the Parish Council as we have alternative areas to use.
 - Scarecrows must be displayed between 9am 28/10/22 and the end of the day on 30/10/22 - although we suspect no one will complain if they stay out for Halloween.
 - All registered scarecrows will need to clearly display the ID poster which will be provided to you after registration.
 - Only registered scarecrows displaying ID numbers will be voted on.
 - Voting starts at 9am 28/10/22 and ends at 9am 01/11/22. Winners will be announced w/c 07/11/22.
 - The parish will be broken down into 3 areas - Great Chart, Singleton and Chilmington. Each area will have a winner.
 - There will also be 3 categories which will include all entries. These are: #Reduce#Reuse#Recycle, Most Creative/Unusual and Under 12 (these must be constructed with only essential help from adults).
 - Scarecrows must be suitable for family viewing, offensive scarecrows will be disqualified.
 - By taking part you agree to photos being taken of your scarecrows which may be used on social media.
