Best Front Garden

Terms and conditions



1. Eligibility:

- The competition is open to residents of Great Chart, Singleton and Chilmington.
- Participants must be the property owners or have permission from the property owner to enter the competition.
- Entries must feature the front garden of a residential property.

2. Entry Submission:

- Entries must be submitted by 15th June 2025.
- Each entry must include at least 3 photographs of the front garden, with one photograph showing the entire garden.
- o Entries can be submitted via email or WhatsApp

3. Judging Criteria:

Gardens will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Overall Best Front Garden: This category recognises the garden that demonstrates exceptional design, maintenance, and curb appeal in all the categories.
- Most Creative Front Garden: This category celebrates innovative and unique garden designs, including creative use of plants, landscaping features, and decorative elements.
- Best Small Front Garden (up to 15m²): This category is specifically for smaller front gardens or spaces, highlighting how creativity and effective design can maximise limited space.
- **Best Flower Display:** Celebrating gardens with the most stunning and vibrant floral displays, including beds, borders, and hanging baskets.
- Best Wildlife-Friendly Front Garden: Recognising gardens that provide habitat and resources for local wildlife, such as birds, butterflies, and bees, through the use of native plants, bird feeders, and wildlife-friendly features.
- The decision of the judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

4. Judging Panel:

- The judging panel will consist of 5 members of the Parish Council including members of the Environment Committee.
- Judges will visit the shortlisted gardens in person to make their final decisions.

5. **Prizes:**

• Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 gardens in each category

1st Prize - £50 Garden Gift Voucher

2nd Prize - £30 Garden Gift Voucher

3rd Prize - £20 Garden Gift voucher.

- The overall winner will receive £100 Garden Gift Voucher
- Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.

6. Announcement of Winners:

- Winners will be announced on **31st July 2025**.
- Winners will be notified by email
- A prize-giving ceremony will be held on 06th September 2025 at Singleton Environment Centre

7. General Conditions:

- Participants agree to maintain the condition of their gardens as represented in their entry until the judging is completed.

- Participants are responsible for ensuring their garden is safe and accessible for the judges.
