(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2025

Kent County Council works.

To allow roundabout works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Sandy Lane & A28 Ashford Road, Great Chart.

Closures are planned from 21st July 2025, with estimated completion by 28th August 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27884605825-01 & GE27806383345-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Sandy Lane & A28 Ashford Road will be closed at the junctions where they meet, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while roundabout works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for Sandy Lane is via A28 Ashford Road, Old Surrenden Manor Road, Vitters Oak Lane and vice versa.

The alternative route for A28 Ashford Road is via the newly constructed A28 Ashford Road Roundabout at the junction with Sandy Lane.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
