NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council proposes to make the above named Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3, 4, 19, 65(1), 124 and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') as amended and all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the Order would be to prohibit all vehicles from entry except cycles and emergency vehicles on the following length of road in Great Chart, Chilmington, Ashford:-

CHILMINGTON GREEN ROAD – From a point 130 metres south east of the junction with Ashford Road for a distance of 3 metres no entry for any vehicles travelling in both directions.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3, 4, 19, 65(1), 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') as amended and all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on xxxx day of xxxxxxxx 2025 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads) (Borough of Ashford) (Various Traffic Movements) (Consolidation) Order (Amendment No.2) Order 2025" ('this Order').
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads) (Borough of Ashford) (Various Traffic Movements) (Consolidation) Order 2025" ('the Order of 2025') shall have effect as though:
 - (a) Schedule 2 to the Order of 2025 is amended by the replacement or issue of the following Map Tile:

4. In Schedule 3 to the Order of 2025 the following entry in the Table below shall be added to the Article 4 exemptions:-

Road / Area Name	Traffic Movement Restriction	Location	Exceptions and addition to Article 4 exemptions
Chimington Green Road, Ashford	Prohibition of Driving	From a point 130 metres south east of its junction with Ashford Road for a distance of 3 metres for vehicles travelling in both directions.	The exemptions in Article 4(a) to 4(c) and 4(k) only are applicable.
