- Any new members of staff will be checked at the point of joining GCwSPC.
 Councillors will be checked at the time of becoming a public office holder either by election or co-option.
- Great Chart with Singleton Parish Council complies fully with the DBS Code of Practice and undertakes to treat all applicants fairly and not to discriminate unfairly against anyone on the basis of conviction or other information revealed. Having a criminal record will not necessarily prevent an individual from being employed. This will depend on the nature of the role, professional suitability and the circumstances, nature and background of the offences.

- The policy will be reviewed in 2023 and 3 years thereafter.
