4. Community Fridge project

4.1. To receive an update and next steps for the project

An update was given on the new volunteers and their roles, including the upcoming newsletter piece and social media message to attract new volunteers and food businesses. The project is now regularly receiving food waste from local co-op shops, and there is work in progress to bring the local Morrisons into the process as well.

New fruit and vegetable display equipment will be purchased and delivered in the next couple of weeks to make the 'green tray' area tidier to look at and more practical for cleaning.

There were issues over Christmas with delivered food being very short dated and fresh food being at its best on delivery. This created a larger than usual amount of food waste with no waste pick up for Lily's as they were closed over the holiday period. In future orders will be cancelled over the entire holiday period.

4.2. To agree the purchase of the storage fridge

It was noted that Option 1 would not fit within the area used for the current fridge without removing shelving or losing floor space. Option 3 was deemed to be the better of the remaining two options. The committee resolved to purchase the tall white Beko fridge at Option 3.
