4. Community Fridge project

The fridge project is running well, however there continues to be a small number of people who take more than they need, leaving the shelves empty for others.

It was noted that a survey will shortly be finished, and volunteers and councillors will be asked to take up a time slot by the fridge to ask a number of questions which will help to evidence the numbers using the fridge and what they are using it for. This will help the project to access further funding.

Using the results of the survey and spending information from the previous financial year, a business case will be devised with options for the future running of the project.

5. Cooking classes

A potential class leader has been found but it was suggested that questions are asked during the fridge survey and on social media to ascertain the level of interest in attending such classes.

6. Christmas Events

A discussion was held on possible sites of any Christmas lights or trees that could be

placed around the parish, with the Singleton Centre and village signs as the most likely. It was suggested that a competition could run for the best decorated house, this would be via a self-registered list and a voting sheet. The logistics of doing this will be investigated before it is agreed.
